SOWING AND GROWING
Soak seed in warm water prior to sowing. Sow May/June in pots in a greenhouse, coldframe or indoors. Maintain 25°C (77°F) for 4-5 weeks then lower to 10°C (50°F). Germination can be slow and erratic (40-60 days). Transplant to a site in full sun or partial shade in autumn to begin flowering the following year. When established, plant out 40cm (15") apart in a sunny position. Protect the plants from frost during winter. May also be sown direct outside.

HELPFUL HINT
Long lasting cut flowers for the home.

Quality Control: This seed has been carefully tested to ensure high germination. Prior to use, store in a dry cool place.
