- Hardy annual - sow direct outside
- Cream-green variegated leaves
- Flowers held well above foliage

SOWING AND GROWING

Sow the seed thinly direct into finely raked, moist, warm, weed-free soil where the plants are to flower 13mm (½") deep. Germination normally takes 10-14 days. As the seedlings develop thin to achieve a final spacing of 25cm (10"). Alternatively, for pots and patio containers sow on a windowsill or in a greenhouse at approx. 13-18°C (55-65°F) 3 or 4 seeds to a 7.5cm (3") pot. Plant out after careful acclimatisation to outside conditions.

FASTFLOWERS flowers in just **10-11 weeks**



Quality Control: This seed has been carefully tested to ensure high germination. Prior to use, store in a dry cool place.
