SOWING AND GROWING

For exhibition, sow thinly Dec/Jan in a propagator on a windowsill or in a greenhouse at approx. 15-20°C (60-68°F). Cover seeds with 6mm (¼") sieved compost. Germination 18-24 days. Transplant seedlings when large enough to handle in 90mm (3") pots, grow on and plant out into prepared soil manured the previous autumn. For culinary use sow thinly direct outside Mar/Apr in finely raked firm soil at a depth of 13mm (½") in rows 30cm (12") apart. Thin seedlings to 15cm (6") between plants. Sowing → Cropping – 24 weeks.

HEALTHY EATING An excellent mild flavoured culinary variety. Largest bulbs not recommended for long storage.
