SOWING AND GROWING

Sow direct into soil prepared by digging and raking at a depth of 50mm (2"), spacing the seeds 20cm (8") apart. Best sown alternately (see illustration) in double rows allowing 23cm (9") between the lines forming each row. Allow 60-90cm (24-36") between further rows. (Germination 7-14 days.) Can also be sown in pots or trays of compost on a windowsill or in a greenhouse for eventual planting outside. Grows best in a sheltered site, but not shaded, in well drained soil. Pinching out tips helps to prevent attacks of blackfly.

Sowing → Cropping – 15 weeks.
