SOWING AND GROWING

Sow in pots or trays on a windowsill or in a greenhouse using a good quality compost. Cover seeds with 38mm (1½") compost (Germination 7-14 days). Grow on, planting outside or protecting with cloches until frost risk has passed, 20cm (8") between plants. Alternatively, sow direct into prepared, warm, moist soil at a depth of 50mm (2"), thinning as necessary to 25cm (10") between plants. Allow 60cm (24") between rows. Grows best in rich, well prepared soil in a sunny position. Water well during dry weather.

Grow under cloches or in pots or grow bags in a greenhouse for earliest crops.

Sowing → Cropping – 9-12 weeks.

HEALTHY EATING

Good source of Vitamin A and dietary fibre.
