SOWING AND GROWING
Sow thinly direct outside into finely raked, moist, warm, weed free soil, 3mm (1/8") deep and cover lightly (Germination 15-30 days). When the seedlings are large enough to handle, transplant them to another well prepared area of the garden allowing 25cm (10") between plants. Plant them in their flowering positions in the autumn allowing 30-38cm (12-15") between them.

HELPFUL HINT
For borders or cut flowers.



Quality Control: This seed has been carefully tested to ensure high germination. Prior to use, store in a dry cool place.
