SOWING AND GROWING

Sow thinly direct into soil prepared by digging and raking at a depth of 50mm (2") in flat drills 15cm (6") wide in two rows with seed approx. 5cm (2") apart (Germination 7-10 days). Allow 60cm (24") between further rows. Support plants with twiggly sticks or pea netting.

Grows best in a sunny position in well cultivated soil containing plenty of well rotted manure or compost.

Sowing → Cropping – 12-16 weeks.

HEALTHY EATING

High in Vitamins B1 and C plus Potassium.



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Quality Control: This seed has been carefully tested to ensure high germination. Prior to use, store in a dry cool place.
